- Student Registration \$75 US
- Picnic \$25 US
- Banquet \$30 US

• Lodging variable and depends on your choice of hotel and if the room is shared (preferred). For budgeting purposes, use \$40 US/night/person.

• Travel cost is variable, but please include RT ground transportation (car rental) to and

from the Dallas Fort Worth airport or Oklahoma City airport.
